Hunters Equipment List

Documents:

Passport – At least 2 blank pages in passport and valid for more than 6 months
Hunt contracts with up to date payment status
Airline Tickets
Taxidermist information, broker name address

Cash & Currency (Methods of payment):

Cashiers or travellers checks made out to Dries Visser Safaris (do not date traveller's checks)
Cash
Cash Wires– Ask for details
Credit cards– Make sure your bank is informed that you will be traveling to South Africa and using your credit card. Note we ask a 5% transaction fee.
Payments at the conclusion of your safari may be made in cash, cashier cheque, credit card or wire transfer (24 hours before departure).
For your convenience, we accept Visa • Master Card • American Express
Please note there is a 3% service fee that will be added to any Visa, Master Card and American Express card payments.
Please make prior arrangements with your credit card company/bank regarding payments to Dries Visser Safaris. This must be done before your safari.
FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN YOUR BANK DECLINING THE TRANSACTION.

Patterns are not critical – darker for blinds & tans for spot & stalk:

Fleece Jacket - Temps to be near freezing in the early morning
Fleece Vest
Medium / Light weight Camo pants (3) (Zipper-o leg style work very good)
Long sleeve Camo Shirts (3)
Long sleeve T-shirts (3)
Ball hat
Face masks
Pair of hiking boots
Under-layer:
Underwear (5)
Socks (5)

Prepare for morning temps 30 – 40(f) and afternoon highs around 70-80 (f) - Very comfortable hunting weather. A warm coat for drive to the blind in the morning, as you often sit in the back of the truck in the observer seat

Day pack:

Binoculars rigged with "Bino-buddy"
Range finder
Extra Batteries
Chapstick
Sunscreen
Sunglasses
Book
Camera
Bug & Tick spray
Baby wipes

Camp clothes:

Sweat pants
Sweat shirt
T-shirts (2)
Camp slippers
Tennis shoes
Small flashlight

Personal bag:

Tooth paste & Tooth brush
Shampoo
Q-tips
Fingernail clipper
Chapstick
